Help Keep Bears Wild

Black bears and other varmints are increasing their raids on residential garbage containers in Amador County upcountry -- even at elevations as low as KC Ranchettes between Highway 88 and Ridge Road.

CA Fish & Wildlife's "Keep Me Wild" website reminds us that bears are attracted to anything that is edible or smelly, and recommends taking the following steps:

- **Keep garbage carts clean and deodorize them by spraying with heavy doses of ammonia or bleach.**
- **Don't put trash out until the morning of collection day.**
- **Put away picnic leftovers; clean BBQ grills, harvest and pick up fruit from trees.**
- **Keep pet food and pets inside.**
- **Don't leave scented products (candles, suntan lotion, insect repellent) outside.**
- **Avoid bird feeders -- they are a powerful attractant.**

ACES drivers have instructions to clean up scattered garbage without question on the first occasion. On the second occasion, they will clean up any mess and place a notice on the cart asking the customer to call the ACES office. On the third time, drivers are instructed to leave the mess.

For handicapped customers with no other able-bodied

person in the household, drivers will continue to clean up after bears. Customers must notify ACES customer service at 209.274.2237 if this is the case.

At no time will ACES drivers leave the truck if a bear is in the immediate area. Please call ACES to let us know if you are having a bear problem.

Amador County Waste Management Dept. holds free HHW collection days at the Buena Vista Transfer Station, every other Saturday, 9 am - 1 pm.
Nov. 7, 21; Dec. 5, 19; Jan. 9, 23.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Thanksgiving: Normal collection. ACES office will be closed Thursday & Friday. Transfer Stations closed on Thursday only.
Christmas Eve & New Year's Eve: Normal collection. Office and Buena Vista Transfer Station will close at 1 pm; Pine Grove Transfer Station will close at noon.
Christmas & New Year's Day: No collection, Office & Transfer Stations closed.

Since Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on a Friday, customers with Friday collection will be serviced on Saturday (Dec. 26 and Jan. 2). The following week after the holidays, everyone reverts back to their regular collection day.

WINTER TRANSFER STATION HOURS:

Nov. 1 through Mar. 7, Buena Vista Transfer Station hours change from 9 am - 5 pm to 8:30 am - 4:30 pm.

Never Climb Into or Onto A Debris Bin

Debris bins are not designed for people to climb onto or into safely.

- Avoid repositioning bin contents by hand. Likewise, never try to compact contents by stepping or stomping.
- Avoid over-filling bins. When they start to get full, call ACES for extra service or to talk about a larger bin.
