Thanksgiving: Normal collection. ACES office will be closed Thursday & Friday. Transfer Stations closed on Thursday. Christmas & New Year's Day: No collection, Office & Transfer Stations closed. Since Christmas Day and New Years Day fall on a Wednesday, customers with Wednesday collection will be serviced on Thursday, Thursday customers serviced on Friday, and Friday customers will be serviced on Saturday. The week of Jan. 6, everyone reverts back to their regular collection day.

Transfer Station Hours Change:

Nov. 3 through Mar. 9, Buena Vista Transfer Station hours change from 9 am - 5 pm to 8:30 am - 4:30 pm.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off:


Nov. 4 - 18; Dec. 7, 21; Jan. 4, 18.

At the Buena Vista Transfer Station, Ione, 9 am - 1 pm. Free, up to 15 gallons or 125 lbs per trip.

Free Christmas Tree Recycling:

Dec. 26, 2024 - Jan. 31, 2025

Trees (all ornaments and lights removed) can be dropped off at the Westover Field airport parking lot Dec. 26 - Jan. 31. Throughout the month of January, trees can also be dropped off at either the Buena Vista Transfer Station daily from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm, or the Pine Grove Transfer Station, Tues. through Sat., 9:00 am - 12 pm & 1:00 - 4:00 pm. The Christmas trees are then recycled locally at the Vicini Brothers Green Waste Recycling Facility and turned into landscape mulch and nutrient rich compost.
